

Internal Medicine Vacation/Personal Day Policy Addendum to the MHG Vacation and Leave of Absence Policy 500.10

Effective July 2023

American Board of Internal Medicine Rule

The ABIM requires all internal medicine trainees to complete 33 months of training to be eligible for the medicine board exam; thus, cumulative leave of more than 3 months (thirteen weeks) for any reason will extend the period of training beyond the traditional 36 months.

Days Off

- Residents may take up to 3 weeks (15 business days) of vacation each academic year.
- Residents will also have 5 personnel days to utilize each academic year.
 residency. These can be used all together for an additional week off if desired.
- Vacation and personnel days may not be utilized on ambulatory, MICU, and inpatient ward rotations.
- Residents can request a weekend(s) off except on MICU or ward rotations.
- Up to 3 professional leave days may be used over the duration of your residency for the sole purpose of interviewing for residency, fellowship, or practice positions.

Process

- Vacation blocks, weekend off, professional and personal days must be submitted to the program coordinator using the vacation request form.
- Time off is to be submitted to the program coordinators 3 months in advance and in 1-week blocks (except for personnel and professional days).
- The weekend prior or the weekend immediately following approved vacations will be scheduled off as determined by the program if not also requested by the resident.

Limitations

- Some calendar dates may be excluded from vacation blocks/professional days as determined by the program.
- Vacation blocks, weekend off, professional days or personnel days must not conflict with previously scheduled patients or other professional/clinical responsibilities.
