REASONABLE SUSPICION OBSERVATION CHECKLIST

"Reasonable Suspicion" drug testing can result from a belief that an individual is using or has used drugs and/or alcohol in violation of Memorial's Drug and Alcohol Policy. Managers should make a recommendation for testing based on specific objective and articulable facts. The checklist below should be used to document the observed behavior.
